## HALLOWEEN FUNDRAISING IDEAS

### PRIZED PUMPKINS

Obtain or put together a spooktacular prize. Charge people to enter a pumpkin which they must carve, the best design wins the prize. Host the competition at your home or a local venue, and allocate judges or ask your audience to vote for their favourite.

### SPOOKTACULAR BAKE SALE

Put your baking skills to use this Halloween and rustle up some deliciously scary treats. You could sell them at work, school or sell to your family and friends.

### HORROR MOVIE-A-THON

Host a film night, charging your friends and family an entry fee, and see how many scary films you can get through! You could try watching the classics, such as A Nightmare on Elm Street, or go for more current horror films, like The Conjuring. Or, get everyone to pick a favourite film each, old or new, and get watching!

Or hold a 24 hour event where you get friends and family to sponsor you to watch horror films for a full 24 hours. The catch is they have to choose the movies you watch.

### SCARY TRIVIA

Have a Halloween-themed quiz with your work, friends, family or your local community. Maybe with a twist. Have a round or two of classic party games, like bobbing for apples (in own buckets) and wrap the mummy. Remember to stock up on loo-roll.

### MONSTER MONEY

Host a Halloween office party and have a costume competition. You could even team up with someone else in the office and have a joint costume, or go all out and organise a full Addams Family.

### HAUNTED HOUSE TRAIL

Invite members of the community to include their house in a Haunted House Trail. Each house pays to get involved and they decorate the outside of their house. Create a map of all the houses involved and charge a fee for the map. As an additional activity create a picture trail where each house places a numbered picture in their window and people have to find them. There could be a prize for the best decorated house, and for the person who finds all the pictures on the trail.
